## Absent from School

The Department of Education's policy on student attendance, includes absences that can be recorded as justified on our school rolls which are legal documents.

Further to this, the table below outlines some of the various reasons for absences, including late arrivals and early leavers, divided into those that can be recorded as justified and those that are to be recorded as unjustified. Unjustified absences are those that cannot be accepted by the school as a reasonable excuse for not having your child at school. Attendance at school is compulsory from 9.20am to 3.15pm daily.

If students are arriving late or leaving early, this has a flow on effect upon others, as teaching and learning is interrupted every time this happens. Please make sure students are here all day, every day unless they are unwell or there are exceptional circumstances.
