Last week, our Year 6 students formally celebrated the end of their schooling at Byron Bay Public School. The Farewell Dinner and Dance was a fitting occasion. #### 2017 Starting date

School resumes for Years 1 to 6 students on Monday, 30 January 2017. The class lists and a school map will be displayed to assist with a smooth start to the new school year. New students starting the year will be required to meet in the school library. Kindergarten students will be having their individual Best Start Assessments on the first four days and will not start class until Friday, 3 February 2017.

#### School Fees and Book Packs

Next year our annual school contribution will be \$75 per student and a book pack fee of \$50. The school contribution will include the Life Education Program, two visiting performances, and student subscriptions to online learning programs, including Mathletics and Reading Eggs, as well as a voluntary contribution to assist the school. Both primary and secondary schools can request contributions to enhance the school's education programs. These school contributions are voluntary and payment is a matter for decision by parents. They help provide additional educational resources for the benefit of students. Principals will ensure that no student or family suffers any discrimination or embarrassment over voluntary school contributions.

The book pack fee (\$50) will ensure every student has all the basic educational supplies. stationery for their classrooms. Parents who are unable to pay book packs because of financial hardship may be eligible for assistance from the school. Payments are accepted at the front office.

#### **School Donations: Building A Better Foundation**

The school has established two tax deductible funds to enable parents, relatives and friends the opportunity to make donations. The Building Fund has provided financial support to complete our school hall renovations, install reverse cycle air-conditioning units in every classroom and construct classroom computer centres. During the next three years, the Building Fund will be used to improve playground facilities. The Library Fund has provided reading materials for guided reading, home reading and the Reading Eggs technology program. This fund will continue to expand reading resources and technology for literacy learning.

#### **Swimming Carnival**




#### **Uniform Shop**
