relatives and friends the opportunity to make donations.


The Building Fund has provided financial support to complete our school hall renovations, install reverse cycle air-conditioning units in every

School Fees and Book Packs

Next year our annual school contribution will be \$80, with a book pack fee of \$55 per student. The school contribution will include the Life Education Program, two visiting performances and student subscriptions to online learning programs, including Matific and Reading Eggs, as well as a voluntary contribution to assist the school. Both primary and secondary schools can request contributions to enhance the school's education programs. These school contributions are voluntary and payment is a matter for decision by parents. They help provide additional educational resources for the benefit of students.

The book pack fee (\$55) will ensure every student has all the basic educational supplies and stationery for their classrooms. Parents who are unable to pay for book packs because of financial hardship may be eligible for assistance from the school. Payments can be made at the front office or online through the school website 'Make a Payment'.
