End of Year

Classes will not operate after today, Wednesday 16 December, which is the last day of attendance for the students. Classes will resume on Friday 29 January 2021 for Years 1 - 6. Kindergarten will be completing their Orientation Program and Best Start interviews during the first few days and will not commence full days until Thursday 11 February 2021.

Two School Development Days

Wednesday 16 December 2020

We are providing you with advanced notice that we will be having two consecutive School Development Days at the beginning of next year, the first one will be on Wednesday 27 and the second one on Thursday 28 January.

The Department of Education has adjusted it's policy on School Development Days and from next year onwards, we will have two School Development Days at the start of the year, followed by one at the start of Term 2 and Term 3, then only one at the end of the year, instead of 2.

Beginning of 2021

At the beginning of next year, students will remain in their current class for a few days until our student numbers are confirmed. 2021 classes will then be finalised. This is due to fluctuating enrolment data. While we have several plans we will not be able to activate final classes until student numbers are confirmed. All students will commence important learning and assessments immediately. Where possible, students will be placed with their 2020 teacher so that learning continuity is assured. They will begin stage assessments and stage based learning. We will advise parents of finalised classes as soon as we can.
