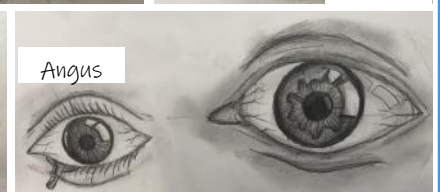
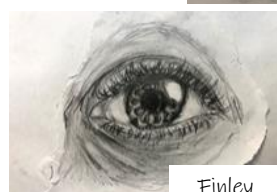
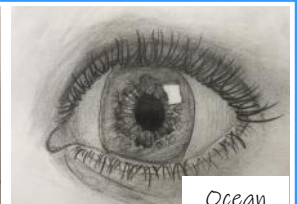
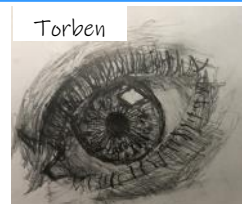
'The Great Wave' Artwork by Year 6



Students in Year 5/6C have been learning about natural disasters. 'The Great Wave off Kanagawa' also known as 'The Great Wave' was the inspiration behind this unit of work. This artwork is a woodblock print by the Japanese ukiyo-e artist Hokusai. It was published sometime between 1829 and 1833 in the Edo period as the first print in Hokusai's series, 'Thirty-six Views of Mount Fuji'. Students recreated this painting using a black outline and watercolour.

6A and 6H students were taken on an artistic journey to recreate a hyper-realistic eye for their still artwork unit. The students focused on their shading and cross-hatching skills.

Staged Departure Times Continue

Staggered departure times for students whose parents are picking them up, will continue this term.

- 3:00 - ES1 (Kindergarten), plus siblings depart
- 3:05 - S1 (Year 1 and Year 2), plus siblings depart
- 3:10 - S2 (Year 3 and Year 4), plus siblings depart
- 3:15 - S3 (Year 5 and Year 6), plus siblings depart

Please make sure the children know which gate you will be collecting them from.

Level 3 Restrictions for Parents

We are asking parents to not enter school grounds and to kiss and drop the children off outside the school gate. The same applies at pick up time. We are still operating under level 3 restrictions which means that parents are not allowed on site. Staff are on duty at each gate in the morning and afternoon. If you are using Kingsley St as a drop off and pick up point, we ask that you please refrain from using the small front gate in Kingsley St which the bus lines use, instead please use the double gates at the entry way to the new building or the gate near Carlyle St. If you are collecting your child/ren, they will only be able to leave the school grounds if you are in line of sight. Please make sure that your child/ren know which gate you will be collecting them from. After drop off time, all gates will be locked. The gates will be unlocked at dismissal time. If you need to collect children early, please phone ahead and let the office know. They will organise for your child/ren to be sent to the office. Please practice social distancing when dropping off and collecting children. Parents are urged, where possible, to kiss and drop off the children. I will let you know when parents are allowed back on site.

Check-in Assessment for Years 3 - 6

Years 3 - 6 students will be participating in a reading and numeracy Check-in Assessment over the next 3 weeks. The Check-in Assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment that they would normally receive in the classroom. Students will participate in this assessment within their class group.
