Music Program

Our Music Program is well resourced with a variety of instruments which aid in the teaching and learning of music. We have percussion instruments - both tuned and untuned, ukuleles, keyboards and guitars. This year, trolleys have been attached to the tuned percussion instruments. This makes playing, moving and storing them so much easier. A big thank you to Jeff Fleming for assembling them. Mr Bailey has been teaching our Year 4 students on a Monday and Mrs Sherab teaches all other classes. In the early years, while some percussion playing is introduced, the emphasis is about developing skills and concepts through voice and movement.

Due to COVID however, singing and chanting is not permitted. So we have adapted. Similarly, due to COVID guidelines, instead of learning the recorder, Year 3 and Year 4 students have had fun playing tuned percussion instruments. Year 5 students continued learning the ukulele - albeit without singing along, whilst Year 6 students are learning about chord playing on keyboards.

Kindergarten 2022

While we are unable to have face to face information sessions regarding Kindergarten enrolments for 2022, the team has organised a virtual information session. We can then ensure that additional information is disseminated to everyone with a view to having a successful transition.

Two School Development Days

We are providing you with advanced notice that we will be having two consecutive School Development Days at the beginning of next year, the first one will be on Friday 28 January and the second one on Monday 31 January.

Last year, the Department of Education adjusted its policy on School Development Days with two School Development Days at the start of the year, followed by one at the start of Term 2 and Term 3, then only one at the end of the year, instead of 2. Students, with the exception of Kindergarten, will commence on Tuesday 1 February. Kindergarten will be completing their Best Start assessments.

Level 3 Restrictions

As of Monday 8 November, all staff and adult visitors must be fully vaccinated and provide proof of vaccination before entry on site is <u>permitted.</u> We are asking parents to not enter school grounds and to kiss and drop the children off outside the school gate. The same applies at pick up time. We are still operating under level 3 restrictions which means that parents are not allowed on site. Please practice social distancing when dropping off and collecting children. I will let you know when parents

are allowed back on site. Please stay in contact with our school via phone calls and emails during this time. We look forward to the day when our school is open to all members of our school community, including our wonderful parents. We miss you and hope all is well with the family.

Planning for 2022

We have commenced our planning and organisation for 2022. If you know that your child/ children won't be attending our school in 2022, with the exception of Year 6 students, could you please inform the office. Similarly, if you are aware of any students moving into our area who will be attending our school in 2022, please ask the families to make contact with the school. This is particularly important if they are Kindergarten students as their Orientation Program has already commenced. We need information about students who will and won't be with us next year in order to work out staffing and classes which are dependent on student numbers. Also, if you are having an extended holiday and your child/children will not be back at school on the first school day in 2022, please let us know in writing, before the end of the year.

The P&C will be holding their monthly meeting tomorrow, Thursday 11 November at 6.00pm via Zoom. A meeting invitation will be sent to P&C members.
